

Dragon Hooded Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern



This adorable dragon hooded baby blanket with wings and horns is perfect for keeping your little one warm and cozy while sparking their imagination. Below you will find the complete crochet pattern, with detailed steps and instructions.

Materials Needed: - Yarn: Soft acrylic yarn in pastel colors (Mint green, pale pink, cream, yellow for horns) - Crochet hook: Size 5 mm (H/8) or size needed to obtain gauge - Yarn needle for sewing parts together - Scissors - Stitch markers

Pattern Instructions: 1. Blanket Base: - Using mint green yarn, chain 100 (or desired width). - Work double crochet (dc) rows until desired length. - Change to pale pink yarn and continue with a granny stitch pattern for a few rows. - Alternate colors as shown in the picture. 2. Hood: - With mint green yarn, chain 50 and work half double crochet (hdc) rows until the hood is about 30 cm long. - Fold in half and seam along the top edge to form the hood shape. - Attach the hood to one corner of the blanket. 3. Dragon Horns and Ears: - Horns (yellow): Magic ring, 6 sc. Work in rounds increasing gradually to form a cone shape. Make two. - Ears (mint green): Chain 10, work in rows with sc decreasing gradually to form ear shape. Make two. 4. Dragon Wings: - With cream yarn, chain 40. - Work in rows with dc increasing at each side to form triangular wings. - Add mint green edging

around wings. - Make two wings and sew to the sides of the blanket. 5. Finishing: - Attach horns, ears, and wings to the hooded blanket. - Add black crocheted or felt eyes and pink nostrils as shown in the photo. - Weave in all ends securely.
